

2011 Program Information & Entry Form

PLEASE, read ALL the following information. Submitting an entry form *constitutes your understanding, acceptance, and agreement of the Rebel Spring Games policies.*

1. Entry Form/Entry Fee/Extra Games

Entry Forms will be accepted until dates requested are full or September 15. Teams requesting weekend only or shortened schedules will be accepted based on availability.

Entry fee is **\$950 and is due September 15, 2010**. Teams participating in the Rebel Spring Games Housing Program receive a **\$200 Housing Credit'** toward their housing (see Preferred Housing Program below).

Teams will receive up to 10 games. Entry fee is not reduced for playing less than 10 games.

Extra games are available in 2 games /day block for additional \$125 per block.

Rebel Spring Games will provide field, opponent, umpires, and game balls.

2. Cancellation and Refund Policy

Team Cancellation - Teams may cancel anytime with written notification before September 15, 2010. Team will receive full refund of Entry Fee will not be refunded for cancellations after September 15, 2010.

Game Cancellations – Every attempt is made to play all games. Occasionally, inclement weather causes delays or cancellations of games. Our policy regarding inclement weather is the following:

Games not started within one (1) hour of published game times due to inclement weather could be cancelled. Game rescheduling is dependent on A) number of team affected, B) team travel schedule, C) availability of fields, and D) availability of opponents. Games may be rescheduled later the same day or on another day.

Teams will not receive a refund for cancelled games due to inclement weather.

3. Playing Dates

You may change your playing dates up to September 15, 2010 depending on space. After September 15, 2010, changes impacting the schedule preparation may result in reduction of available games for your team.

Our schedule is limited to a maximum of 60 games per day. We do experience days where this maximum is reached and cannot accept changes to requested play dates.

4. Team Travel

Coach is responsible for completing team travel so team is available to play any time on requested play dates.

The cost of air travel is expensive and you may find cheaper airfare by adjusting your travel date. Most date changes are caused by airfare differences. Please remember September 15th is the deadline for providing your playing dates.

Please allow adequate arrival time the night before your first playing date for a possible 9:00 am game. Team not available for 9:00 am game due to late arrival the night prior is considered to be traveling on playing date and team could be dropped from that day's schedule. This program does not accept specific game date and time requests.

5. Schedule

Your schedule is based on information you provide to this program. Teams are required to play 2 games per day each date you are scheduled to play. Single or triple headers are not scheduled.

Game times will be 9:00 am, 11:00 am, 1:00 pm, 3:00 pm, and 5:00 pm. Games will be played back to back as much as possible.

Opponents will be within the same division (exception is NAIA opponent) unless you indicate willingness to play a lower division team. Due to scheduling restrictions, teams may have to play some teams a second time.

Due to size and complexity of scheduling, very little flexibility is available to accommodate special requests. Teams are assumed to be available any time of day on dates reserved to play. Special requests will be accommodated if possible. **Special requests are not guaranteed.**

Teams will be given a day off in the middle of their trip based on number of game and travel dates. If you have a special event planned (i.e. family or alumni picnic, etc), you may request a specific day off. Every attempt will be made to grant one (1) requested day off.

Team flexibility in scheduling their day off is greatly appreciated.

Rebel Spring Games schedule will have priority over games scheduled outside the program.

6. Preferred Housing Program

The Rebel Spring Games is partnered with area housing providers to provide you and your fans discounted room rates. Housing options include motels/hotels, suites/condos, and vacation homes at varying prices and locations.

New to the Rebel Spring Games (coming later this summer) is our online Hotel/Motel reservation system. Teams and fans can reserve their housing through our secure reservation system, make payment, and receive confirmation directly from the Rebel Spring Games website.

Teams participating in the Preferred Housing program will receive a \$200 Housing credit reducing their overall travel cost.

Note: GLOBAL/RCBI or Florida Leisure will continue to handle reservations directly. Please contact them for executive homes.

7. Game Ball Sponsor

The official ball of the Rebel Spring Games is the NCAA championship ball.
