

2012 Program Information & Entry Form

PLEASE, read ALL the following information. Submitting an entry form *constitutes your understanding, acceptance, and agreement of the Rebel Spring Games policies.*

***** PROGRAM CHANGES beginning in 2012 *****

- A. Teams can play 1, 2, or 3 games per day. Teams, wishing to play 1 or 3 games will require another team wanting to play 1 or 3 games.
- B. Extra Games (more than 10 games) – Extra games are accepted for 1 or 2 or 3 games per day. Cost for each game is \$65.
- C. Preferred Housing Credit - See requirements for receiving credit below under Preferred Housing Program Details.

1. **Program Dates** are February 26 through March 25, 2012

2. **Fees**

Entry Forms will be accepted until dates requested are full or September 15. Teams requesting weekend only or shortened schedules will be accepted based on availability.

Entry fee is **\$950 and is due October 1, 2011**. If you are not able to meet the September 1 due date, please contact the program for additional time.

Teams participating in the Rebel Spring Games Housing Program receive a **\$200 Housing Credit** toward their housing (see Preferred Housing Program requirements below). Credit is applied to housing invoice.

Teams will receive up to 10 games. Entry fee is not reduced for playing less than 10 games.

Extra games are available for additional \$65 per game.

Rebel Spring Games will provide field, opponent, umpires, and game balls.

3. **Cancellation and Refund Policy**

Team Cancellation - Teams may cancel before September 15, 2011. Team will receive full refund of Entry Fee.

Game Cancellations – Every attempt is made to play all games. Occasionally, inclement weather causes delays or cancellations of games. Our policy regarding inclement weather is the following:

- A. Games not started within one (1) hour of published game times due to inclement weather could be cancelled.
- B. Games halted will be subject to the NCAA Halted Game rule.
- C. Games maybe rescheduled later in the day or another day subject to field and opponent availability.
- D. Teams will not receive a refund for cancelled games due to inclement weather.

4. Playing Dates

You may change your playing dates up to October 1 depending on space. After October 1, changes impacting the schedule preparation may result in reduction of available games for your team.

Our schedule is limited to a maximum of 60 games per day. We do experience days where this maximum is reached. Requests to add games on these dates will be placed on a waiting list.

5. Team Travel

Coach is responsible for completing team travel **so team is available to play any time on requested play dates.**

The cost of air travel is expensive and you may find cheaper airfare by adjusting your travel date. Please remember September 15th is the deadline for providing your playing dates.

Please allow adequate arrival time the night before your first playing date for a possible 9:00 am game. Teams not available for 9:00 am game due to late arrival the night prior are considered to be traveling on playing date and team could be dropped from that day's schedule.

6. Schedule and Day Off

Your schedule is based on information you provide to this program. Teams are required to play 2 games per day each date you are scheduled to play. Single or triple headers are not scheduled.

Game times will be 9:00 am, 11:00 am, 1:00 pm, 3:00 pm, and 5:00 pm. Games will be played back to back as much as possible. This will require some teams switching fields.

Opponents will be within the same division unless you indicate willingness to play outside your division. Due to scheduling restrictions, teams may have to play some teams a second time.

Due to size and complexity of scheduling, special requests may not be accommodated. Special requests will be accommodated if possible. **Special requests are not guaranteed.**

If you have a special event planned (i.e. family or alumni picnic, etc), you may request a specific day off. Every attempt will be made to grant one (1) requested day off.

Teams will be given a day off in the middle of their trip based on number of game and travel dates. Team flexibility in scheduling their day off is greatly appreciated.

Rebel Spring Games schedule will have priority over games scheduled outside the program.

7. Game Balls

The official ball of the Rebel Spring Games is the NCAA championship ball.

8. Preferred Housing Program

The Rebel Spring Games is partnered with area housing providers to provide teams and fans discounted room rates. Housing options vary and include motels/hotels, suites/condos, and vacation homes at different price ranges and locations.

Teams participating in the Preferred Housing program will receive a \$200 Housing credit.

Reservations must be made through the Rebel Spring Games reservation system (through our website) or directly with Florida Leisure or Global/RCBI.

Rebel Spring Games Reservation System

- 1) Reservations must be made prior to December 1.
- 2) Adjustments/Changes can be made up to February 1.
- 3) Payment to Rebel Spring Games.
- 4) Twenty (20%) percent deposit must be received by December 1.
- 5) Balance due February 1.
- 6) Housing Credit is deducted on your Housing Invoice not the Entry Fee Invoice.
